



# REQUIEM

CELEBRATE LIFE WITH A KINETIC SCULPTURE THAT TELLS THE TIME

**A table clock with an 8-day movement designed in partnership with Kostas Metaxas.**

Requiem is a table clock designed and manufactured by L'Epée 1839, Swiss specialist of high-end kinetic clocks. It measures nearly 19 centimeters (7.4 inches) high and weighs about 2 kilograms (6 pounds). It is made of cast aluminum which is then perfectly finished off in the Swiss workshops of L'Epée 1839. Three skull finishings are available: a black skull associated with a movement in gold-

plated brass, or a silver color version: aluminum skull and palladium-plated movement, and a rainbow skull that has his own color in between violet, green with many more reflections of light. The new movement is an internally designed 1853 HMD caliber with an 8-day power reserve. This new movement features two discs that display a "slow" jumping hour and sweeping minutes.
