AN ALARM CLOCK WITH CENTURIES OF HISTORY

The name «Corniche» comes from the elaborate moulding, or corniche, round top. This collection made the L'Épée 1839 brand known as «The clock of the powerful».

The first authentic carriage clock was made in Paris at the start of the 19th Century under the auspices of the great Abraham-Louis Breguet (1747-1823). The «Corniche» collection is the most well-known clock of the L'Épée collection through

its nearly 200 years of achievements. In fact, during the 20th century, the «L'Épée 1839 Corniche» was the gift of choice by French government officials to elite guests. So, for many, L'Épée was the brand of the influential and powerful.
